Role and Responsibilities

- Work alongside the Rail Team carrying out preparation work for 4 year' intermediate and 8 year periodic tank inspections
- The use and operation of Breathing Apparatus / Gas Monitors
- Basic Pipework removal
- Tank and pipework decommissioning
- Air operated cold cutting
- Manual handling
- Working at height
- Rescue procedures

- Understanding, adherence and acceptance of Risk Assessments and Method statements as well as the ability to complete Dynamic Risk Assessments
- Utilising a variety of tools to remove hazardous materials whilst working in a safe manner at all times to avoid taking unnecessary risks
- Co-operating with line management in ensuring that personnel, contractors and visitors comply with site rules.
- Work alongside your team in the development of equipment, plant and systems in order to improve safety, health, environmental and quality standards and operational efficiency.
